

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. Memorandum of Agreement**  
**for the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and**  
**Children, October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2015)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-359**

1 **WHEREAS, funding for the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and**  
2 **Children (WIC) Program is authorized by the Congress through Section 17 of the "Child**  
3 **Nutrition Act of 1966, as amended", and funds for such programs to state agencies are**  
4 **made available through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Secretary of Agriculture is authorized to make grants to "State Agencies" for the**  
6 **purpose of administering a WIC Program; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the definition in the law, under Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.2, for state agency includes "an**  
8 **Indian tribe, band or group recognized by the Department of the Interior; an**  
9 **intertribal council or group which is the authorized representative of Indian Tribes,**  
10 **bands or groups recognized by the Department of Interior and which has an ongoing**  
11 **relationship with such tribes, bands or groups for other purposes and has contracted**  
12 **with them to administer the programs"; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (ITCA) serves as the state agency and in**  
14 **accordance with Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.6(a) is required to enter into a signed written**  
15 **agreement with each Agency that sets forth the local agency's responsibilities for**  
16 **program operations as prescribed in Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.6(b); and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did enter into a Memorandum of Agreement, which was**  
18 **approved through Resolution No. 02-439, with the ITCA to fund and operate the WIC**  
19 **Program which will commence on October 1, 2012; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has continued to serve as the local WIC Agency which**  
21 **successfully operated the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women,**  
22 **Infants and Children.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
24 **approve the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona Memorandum of Agreement for the**  
25 **Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children, October**  
26 **1, 2012 through September 30, 2015 substantially in the form attached hereto.**

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

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day of SEPTEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


