1	WHEREAS,the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2	Council with the power to appoint Judicial Court judges, to protect and promote
3	individual rights, and to enact laws providing for the administration of justice and
4	other aspects of the Nation's justice system (Constitution, Article III, Article V, Section
5	1, Article VI, Section 1 and Article VIII); and
6	WHEREAS, in December 2008, the Legislative Council repealed the Nation's outdated and
7	conflicting court laws and enacted 6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1, Courts and
8	Procedures, which addresses the jurisdiction of the Nation's courts, qualifications and
9	appointment of judges, the protection and promotion of individual rights, and other
10	matters pertaining to the Judicial Branch (Resolution No. 08-704, veto overridden by
11	Resolution No. 08-713; subsequently amended by Resolutions No. 11-489, No. 12-169
12	and No. 12-267); and
13	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council continues to exercise its legislative power to clarify and amend α
14	the Nation's laws; and
15	WHEREAS, in order to fully exercise its right to self-determination as a sovereign triba
16	government, to protect and maintain individual rights, and to provide for the
17	administration of justice, it is in the Nation's best interest to appoint highly qualified
18	Judicial Court judges while also promoting the appointment of enrolled members of
19	the Nation; and
20	$f WHEREAS,\ the Judiciary Committee accordingly recommends that the Legislative Council amend$
21	6T.O.C. Chapter 1, subsection 1103(C) in accordance with the October 2012 Courts and
22	Procedures Amendments, which are incorporated by this reference.
