

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of amendment 1 to the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering and Tracking Office, Sex Offender Registration, Tracking, Enforcement, and Notification Division budget, Grant No. 2011-AW-BX-0018 and approval of the FY 2013 budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-409

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has applied for and was awarded the Department of**
2 **Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Sex Offender Registration, Tracking,**
3 **Enforcement and Notification Division Grant, Grant No. 2011-AW-BX-0018 through**
4 **Resolution No. 11-539; and**

5 **WHEREAS, this grant period is from October 1, 2011 through March 31, 2013; and**

6 **WHEREAS, a request for amendment to the grant was submitted and approved to include the**
7 **change in salary for the two positions under this grant that occurred due to the**
8 **Tohono O'odham Nation wage study and cost of living; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this grant allows for Indirect Cost and has been budgeted at the rate of 18.82%; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has prepared an FY 2013 budget,**
11 **which has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants & Contracts, Executive Office,**
12 **Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of all which**
13 **recommend acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **approves the FY 2013 DOJ OJP Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending,**
16 **Registering and Tracking Office, Sex Offender Registration, Tracking and Enforcement**
17 **and Notification Division Grant budget in the amount of \$156,787.16 from October 1,**
18 **2012 thru March 31, 2013.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
20 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
24 **of OCTOBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Article VI, Section 1 (D) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**
