12		which amends the budget justification for line item 7340 Public Relations; and
13	WHEREAS,	the budget amendment does not change the amount of funds budgeted for FY 2013;

15	WHEREAS,	the FY 2013 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1 has been reviewed by the
16		Appropriations and Budget and Finance Committees.
