

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recessing November 8, 2012 General Session)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 12-433

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1(B)(2) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
6 **Council provides that "A monthly general session of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
7 **Council shall be held on dates specified in the legislative calendar adopted by the**
8 **Legislative Council"; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation's annual 2012 Diabetes Health Fair is scheduled concurrently with the**
10 **November 8, 2012 general session; and**


11 **WHEREAS, a request has been made by the Health and Human Services Committee to recess the**
12 **November 8, 2012 general session to allow Legislative Council representatives to**
13 **attend the 2012 Diabetes Health Fair.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the November**
15 **general session shall recess on November 8, 2012 to allow Legislative Council**
16 **representatives to attend the 2012 Diabetes Health Fair.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that the period of recess for the November general session shall**
18 **commence on November 7, 2012 following the completion of agenda items and shall**
19 **resume on November 9, 2012.**


20 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of**
21 **NOVEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
23 **VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
25 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
