5	enter into an Self-Determination Contract (the "Contract") with the BIA for
6	preconstruction & tribal management of Project PIR 1006(1), Project I.D. Number H54
7	303: Route 1006, Gu Vo Loop Road (the "Project"); and
8	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Contract (P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. A12AV0079), the BIA will obligate
9	funds to the Nation in the amount of \$175,950 for the Project; and
10	WHEREAS, the Nation has informed the BIA that the Nation plans to subcontract with a private
11	engineering consultant firm to provide the engineering and related studies, the
12	construction plans, specifications, and engineering cost estimate (PS&E), as well as
13	second level review for the Project, as authorized by 25 CFR 170.162(a); and
14	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Planning & Economic Development Department Roadway
15	Program presented the Nation's proposal to contract this transportation project to the
16	Domestic Affairs, Commerce and the Agricultural & Natural Resources Committees
17	who have reviewed and recommend its approval.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
19	authorizes P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. A12AV0079 with the BIA for Project PIR 1006(1)
20	substantially in the form attached hereto.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes
22	any amendments to P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. A12AV0079 to allow the Tohono
23	O'odham Nation to perform the preconstruction activities and second level design
24	reviews for the Project PIR 1006(1) as authorized by 25 CFR 170.162(a).
25	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairperson is authorized to execute the documents necessary
26	to fulfill the intent of this resolution.
