1	WHEREAS,	pursuant to the Indian Law Enforcement Reform Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2801-2809, the
2		Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"), is
3		responsible for providing, or assisting in providing, law enforcement in Indian
4		Country; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Secretary has delegated this authority to the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
6		and the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs has re-delegated this authority to the
7		Director of the BIA, who has re-delegated it to the Deputy Bureau Director, Law
8		Enforcement Services, BIA; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs is committed to working with tribal
10		governments and tribal law enforcement to strengthen law enforcement in Indian
11		country; and
12	WHEREAS,	on February 10, 2004, the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs articulated policy
13		guidance to the BIA - as published at 69 Federal Register page 6,321, to govern the
14		implementation of Special Law Enforcement Commission Deputation Agreements
15		with Indian tribes; and
16	WHEREAS,	this policy expressly lays out issues regarding good faith efforts on behalf of all parties
17		$involved\ in\ the\ aforementioned\ agreements, including\ as\ they\ relate\ to\ liability; and$
18	WHEREAS,	the TohonoO' od hamPoliceDepartment("TOPD")provideslawenforcementservices
19		to the Tohono O'odham Nation and has expressed a need to deputize its officers with
20		SpecialLawEnforcementCommissionssothatTOPDofficerscanenforceawiderangesothatTOPDofficerscanenforce
21		of federalcriminallawswithinthelandsoftheTohonoO'odhamNation, andseekstohonoO'odhamNation, andseekstohonoO'odham
22		enter into a Deputation Agreement with the BIA Office of Law Enforcement Services;

24	WHEREAS,	the attached Deputation Agreement has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs
25		Committee, which recommends approval by the Legislative Council.
26	NOW, THEF	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
27		Deputation Agreement Between the Bureau of Indian Affairs Law Enforcement
28		Services and the Tohono O'odham Nation substantially in the form attached hereto,
29		and authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to execute it.
