1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the Department of Justice, Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Nation Project Safe Neighborhoods Pilot Grant #2009-GP-BX-0096; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation requested and was approved for the no-cost extension for**  
4 **the grant period by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs; and**

5 **WHEREAS, this grant and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants &**  
6 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**  
7 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant amendment by the**  
8 **Legislative Council; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this grant does not require Indirect Cost.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
11 **no-cost extension period and FY 2013 Budget of the Department of Justice Programs,**  
12 **Tohono O'odham Nation Project Safe Neighborhoods Pilot Grant #2009-GP-BX-0096**  
13 **to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from Grantor for the**  
14 **continuation of grant.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**  
16 **TONPD to expend funds from the Department of Justice, Project Safe Neighborhoods**  
17 **Pilot Grant #2011-GP-BX-0030 in accordance with the terms of the grant award period**  
18 **of 08/01/09 to 07/31/13.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**  
21 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
24 **of NOVEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
26 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
