2	Nation Project Safe Neighborhoods Pilot Grant #2009-GP-BX-0096; and
3	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation requested and was approved for the no-cost extension for
4	the grant period by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs; and
5	WHEREAS, this grant and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants &
6	Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance
7	Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant amendment by the
8	Legislative Council; and
9	WHEREAS, this grant does not require Indirect Cost.
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
11	no-cost extension period and FY 2013 Budget of the Department of Justice Programs,
12	Tohono O'odham Nation Project Safe Neighborhoods Pilot Grant #2009-GP-BX-0096
13	to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from Grantor for the
14	continuation of grant.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes
16	TONPD to expend funds from the Department of Justice, Project Safe Neighborhoods
17	Pilot Grant#2011-GP-BX-0030 in accordance with the terms of the grant award period
18	of 08/01/09 to 07/31/13.
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
20	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as
21	attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
22	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
