

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Amendment of the Grant Award for the USEPA Clean Air Act Grant
- Amendment #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-447

1 WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$85,000.00 in new funding for the
2 continuation of the Clean Air Act Grant by Resolution No. 12-243; and

3 WHEREAS, on August 31, 2012 the USEPA Region 9 issued the Grant Agreement award in the
4 amount of \$75,000.00 for the Clean Air Act Grant from October 1, 2012 through
5 September 30, 2013; and

6 WHEREAS, there is a difference in the original amount of \$85,000.00 less \$10,000.00; and

7 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Office (EPO) has prepared a budget amendment to
8 adjust line items to reflect the new award; and

9 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative
10 Council has reviewed Budget Amendment #1 and recommends its approval and
11 adoption.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
13 budget Amendment #1 in accordance with the attached hereto:

- 14 1. Decreasing the FY2013 budget (\$10,000.00).
- 15 2. Changing the budget amount from \$85,000.00 to \$75,000.00.

16 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Tohono O'odham
17 Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairperson and any designated official are hereby
18 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
19 amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the grant shall be submitted for
20 further prior approval.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day
22 of NOVEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-
23 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
24 VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
25 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
26 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
27 Stat. 984).
