

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Nominating Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association Executive Director to the Housing
and Urban Development's Negotiated Rulemaking Committee)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-455

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority to “consult with the Congress of the**
2 **United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities that affect**
3 **the Tohono O'odham Nation. . .” and “to promote, protect and provide for public**
4 **health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
5 **and its members. . .” (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(j) and Section 1(c)(2)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council established the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association (“TOKA”) as**
7 **the Nation’s tribally designated housing entity in accordance with Article VI of the**
8 **Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and pursuant to Legislative Council**
9 **Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended (“TOKA Ordinance”), 18 T.O.C. Ch. 1, [www.tolc-](http://www.tolcnsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf)**
10 **[nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf](http://www.tolcnsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf)); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the TOKA receives a large portion of its annual funding from the Indian Housing Block**
12 **Grant program allocated pursuant to a formula under the Native American Housing**
13 **Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (“NAHASDA”); and**

14 **WHEREAS, on July 3, 2012, U.S. Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) published a Federal**
15 **Register notice announcing its intent to initiate negotiated rulemaking for the**
16 **purpose of developing regulatory changes to the funding formula for Indian Housing**
17 **Block Grants; and**

18 **WHEREAS, membership on the negotiated rulemaking committee is generally limited to 25**
19 **members and should reflect potentially affected tribes from diverse geographic areas;**
20 **and**

21 **WHEREAS, nominations for individuals interested in the membership on the negotiated**
22 **rulemaking committee are due before November 19, 2012; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Housing Committee recommends nominating TOKA's Executive Director Pete**
24 **Delgado to the negotiated rulemaking committee; and**

25 **WHEREAS, as an enrolled Nation’s member with experience in government and law, Executive**
26 **Director Delgado would bring a valuable combination of skills to represent the needs**
27 **of Nation’s members and Indian Country as a whole.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it nominates**
29 **TOKA’s Executive Director Pete Delgado to HUD’s negotiated rulemaking committee.**



2 this nomination and appoint Executive Director Delgado to the negotiated rulemaking
3 committee.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH Day
5 of NOVEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,152.80 FOR;
6 415.90 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 211.90 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
7 Council by Article VI, Section 1 (j) and (c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
8 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
9 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
10 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




