9		Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended ("TOKA Ordinance"), 18 T.O.C. Ch. 1, www.tolc-
10		nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf); and
11	WHEREAS,	the TOKAreceivesalargeportionof itsannualfundingfromtheIndianHousingBlock
12		Grant program allocated pursuant to a formula under the Native American Housing
13		Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 ("NAHASDA"); and
14	WHEREAS,	on July 3, 2012, U.S. Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") published a Federal
15		Register notice announcing its intent to initiate negotiated rulemaking for the
16		${\bf purpose}\ {\bf of}\ {\bf developing}\ {\bf regulatory}\ {\bf changes}\ {\bf to}\ {\bf the}\ {\bf funding}\ {\bf formula}\ {\bf for}\ {\bf Indian}\ {\bf Housing}$

18	WHEREAS,	membership on the negotiated rulemaking committee is generally limited to 25
19		members and should reflect potentially affected tribes from diverse geographic areas;

21	WHEREAS,	nominations for individuals interested in the membership on the negotiated
22		rulemaking committee are due before November 19, 2012; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Housing Committee recommends nominating TOKA's Executive Director Pete
24		Delgado to the negotiated rulemaking committee; and
25	WHEREAS,	as an enrolled Nation's member with experience in government and law, Executive
26		${\bf Director Delgado would bring a valuable combination of skills to represent the needs}$
27		of Nation's members and Indian Country as a whole.
28	NOW, THEI	$\textbf{REFORE}, \textbf{BE IT RESOLVED} \ \textbf{by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it nominates}$
