6		Tohono O'odham Nation" to "call a referendum within ninety (90) days from the date
7		of the receipt of a valid petition" (Constitution, Article XIV); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Uniform Election Ordinance, Ordinance No. 03-86, requires the Election Board to
9		verify and then certify that a minimum of 300 registered voters of the Tohono O'odham
10		Nation have signed the referendum petition (Election Ordinance, Article XII, Section
11		7); and
12	WHEREAS,	by its letter delivered October 24, 2012, the Election Board certified and notified the
13		Legislative Conncil chairperson that Referendum Petition No. 02-12, entitled,
14		"Enacting Tohono O'odham Code Title 17, Chapter 7 - Animal Control. Resolution #07-
15		025" ("Referendum") received a minimum of 300 valid signatures; and
16	WHEREAS,	based upon the Election Board's certification, the Legislative Council has called a
17		special election for January 19, 2013 to allow the Nation's voters to consider the
18		Referendum (Legislative Order No. 12-449); and
19	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article XII, Section 11.B of the Election Ordinance,
20		"Not later than sixty days preceding the election the council, after providing
21		reasonable opportunity for comments by all representatives, shall prepare and file
22		with the Election Board an analysis of the provisions of each ballot proposal of a
23		measure together with a list of popular arguments favoring and opposing each
24		proposal. Each argument favoring and opposing each such proposal shall not exceed
25		three hundred words in length."
