6	Awards, 7000 Supplies - Office, 7010 Program Supplies, 7060 Food, 7355 Professiona
7	Services and 7665 Client Support; and
8	WHEREAS, the Johnson O'Malley Program Budget Amendment #1 allows the creation of new line
9	items 6510 Lodging, 6520 Per Diem, 6530 Transportation, 6600 Employee Tuition Aid
10	7005 Supplies - Office Equipment and 7110 Communication Expense; and
11	WHEREAS, the Johnson O'Malley Budget Amendment #1 has been reviewed by the Human
12	Resources Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the
13	Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and
14	adoption.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
