

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Supporting the Nomination of Representative Billman Lopez to the Advisory**  
**Committee on Climate Change and Natural Resource Science)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-498**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the**  
2 **authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education**  
3 **and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members. . ." and with the**  
4 **authority to "consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal**  
5 **agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation. . ."**  
6 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, on October 4, 2012, the Department of the Interior published a notice announcing the**  
8 **establishment of the Advisory Committee on Climate Change and Natural Resource**  
9 **Science ("Committee") and inviting nominations for membership to the approximately**  
10 **25-member committee (77 Fed. Reg. 60,717-60,718 and 77 Fed. Reg. 70,182); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Committee, which will be comprised of 25 members from federal, state and local**  
12 **governments, non-governmental organizations, academia, Native American tribes,**  
13 **individual landowners, and business interests, will advise on matters and actions**  
14 **relating to the establishment and operations of the U.S. Geological Survey National**  
15 **Climate Change and Wildlife Science Center and the DOI Climate Science Centers; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee recommends nominating**  
17 **Representative Billman Lopez to the Advisory Committee on Climate Change and**  
18 **Natural Resource Science.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it supports**  
20 **the nomination of Representative Billman Lopez to the Advisory Committee on**  
21 **Climate Change and Natural Resource Science.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of DECEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -01- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Article VI, Section 1 (c)(2) & (j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






