RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting Uniform Election Ordinance Automated Tabulation Amendments for the Tohono O'odham Nation 2013 Election)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-504

1	WHEREAS, in 1986 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation adopted the Constitution of the

3	Tohono O'odham Nation and directed the Legislative Council to
4	enact an election ordinance which shall present to such a family of the
5	enact an election ordinance which shall prescribe rules for the apportionment of representatives to each district council when elections of such representatives are
6	from communities within the district and not from the district at large, and for the
7	setting and holding of primary elections for the offices of chairman and vice chairman
8	of the Tohono O'odham Council and of the district council, and which shall prescribe
9	the qualifications of candidates, the registration requirements for voting and such
10	other rules and procedures necessary to the orderly conduct of elections, including
11 12	but not limited to procedures for validation of petitions and the settlement of any and
12	all election disputes. The decision of the Tohono O'odham Council in all election
13 14	matters, including the eligibility and qualifications of candidates, shall be final.
15	(Constitution, Article X, Section 7); and

17	WHEREAS, on June 28, 2012, the Legislative Council unanimously voted to appropriate \$30,000 in
	supplemental funding to the Election Program to implement "electronic voting" (also
18	known as "automated tabulation") on the Nation (Resolution No. 12-240); and
19	WHEREAS, in order to modernize the Nation's system of balloting and ballot counting by
20	implementing automated tabulation, it is necessary to make the limited Uniform
21	Election Ordinance amendments appearing in the "Uniform Election Ordinance
22	Automated Tabulation Amendments" as dated for reference December 19, 2012, which
23	are incorporated by this reference; and
24	WHEREAS, the proposed amendments would greatly simplify voting, consolidate contests for
25	multiple offices on a single ballot, eliminate the use of hand-written ballots, and
26	greatly increase the speed and accuracy of ballot tabulation; and
27	WHEREAS, in multiple public hearings the Nation's members, many of whom currently vote in
28	other elections employing automated tabulation, have universally supported this
29	modernization of the Nation's voting system.
30	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the
31	"Uniform Election Ordinance Automated Tabulation Amendments" as dated for
32	reference December 19, 2012; provided that the special election for Referendum No.
