

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) Fiscal Year  
2013 Budget Amendment 1, Account #700-13-6222)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-010**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated programs for the Elders of the**  
2 **Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Division is possible in part by the Title**  
4 **VI of the Older Americans Act of 1978 as amended and administered by the**  
5 **Administration of Aging; and**

6 **WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 12-131 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
7 **original FY 2013 Title VI Program Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) budget**  
8 **for \$2,518.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received the actual Notice of Award; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Senior Services has**  
11 **prepared the attached FY 2013 budget amendment #1 to accommodate the new**  
12 **allocation; utilizing the additional funds in line items 7060 – Food and 9000 – IDC to**  
13 **increase the budget from \$2,518.00 to \$3,426.00; increase of \$908.00; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**  
15 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget amendment and recommend its**  
16 **approval and adoption.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
18 **approves: the Department of Health and Human Services; Division of Senior Services**  
19 **Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) FY2013 budget amendment #1**  
20 **that accommodates the new fund allocation; utilizing the additional funds in line**  
21 **items 7060 and 9000 – IDC and increasing the budget from \$2,518.00 to \$3,426.00**  
22 **(Increase of \$908.00).**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit, the Chairperson and**  
24 **any designated official is hereby authorized to expend the budget, provided however,**  
25 **that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be**  
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**






