

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Nation to Enter into a P.L. 638 Contract with BIA for Project PIR 101 (2),
Project I.D. Number H54 313: Route 101 (2), Artesia Wash Bridge)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-012

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe and**
2 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is the governing**
3 **body of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation, through the Planning & Economic Development Department**
5 **("Department"), seeks to enter into a SelfDetermination Contract (the "Contract") with**
6 **the BIA for preconstruction & tribal management of Project PIR 101 (2), Project I.D.**
7 **Number H54 313: Route 101 (2), Artesia Wash Bridge (the "Project"); and**

8 **WHEREAS, pursuant to the P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. CTH54T61080, the BIA will obligate funds**
9 **to the Nation in the amount of \$2,800,000 for the Project; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Nation plans to subcontract with a private engineering consultant firm to provide**
11 **the engineering and related studies, the construction plans, specifications, and**
12 **engineering cost estimate (PS&E), as well as second level review for the Project, as**
13 **authorized by 25 CFR 170.462(a); and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Department's Roadway Program presented the Nation's proposal to contract this**
15 **transportation project to the Commerce and the Agricultural & Natural Resources**
16 **Committees who recommend its approval; the Department also presented P.L. 93-638**
17 **Agreement No. CTH54T61080 to the Domestic Affairs Committee who recommends its**
18 **approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
20 **authorizes P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. CTH54T61080 with the BIA for Project PIR 101**
21 **(2) substantially in the form attached hereto.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**
23 **any amendments to P.L. 93-638 Agreement No. CTH54T61080 to allow the Tohono**
24 **O'odham Nation to perform the preconstruction activities and second level design**
25 **reviews for the Project PIR 101 (2) as authorized by 25 CFR 170.462(a).**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairperson is authorized to execute the documents necessary**
27 **to fulfill the intent of this resolution.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH Day**
29 **of JANUARY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
31 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
32 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
34 **Stat. 984).**

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




