1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Master 477 budget administers all combined federal
2	programs under the Education Department One Stop Division from October 1, 2012
3	to September 30, 2013 in the combined amount of \$1,927,688.50 with carry forward
4	included; and
5	WHEREAS, the Master 477 budget had been developed and cost shared with the Arizona
6	Department of  Economic Security funding to promote smooth transitional services for
7	clients with an effective cost share to promote de-centralized services; and
8	WHEREAS, Grants and Contracts have identified a preliminary year-end balance in the amount
9	of \$694,454.41 pending FY12 closeout and the One Stop Division request to amend the
10	FY 13 Master 477 Budget to include carry forward amount as identified; and
11	WHEREAS, the Master 477 budget will be amended after FY12 has been closed and a final balance
12	has been identified; and
13	   WHEREAS, the Education Department-One Stop Division 477 Budget was reviewed by the Human
14	Resources Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
16	approve and authorize amendment #1 of the FY 2013 Master 477 Budget for the
17	Education Department – One Stop Division effective October 1, 2012 to September 30,
18	2013 in the amount of \$1,927,688.50.
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
20	Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairperson and any official appointed designee is hereby
21	authorized to expend the budget, provided however, that any amendment affecting
22	the funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for further prior
23	approval by this Council.
24	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>09<sup>TH</sup> Day</u>
25	of JANUARY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,780.60</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u>
26	AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
<b>27</b>	VI, Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
28	O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
29	Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
30	Stat. 984).
