RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Requesting Secretary of Health and Human Services to Direct Centers for Medicare and Medicaid to Waive Licensure Requirement)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-023

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the C
2		$authority \hbox{\it ``to promote'}, protect \hbox{\it and provide for public health'}, peace, morals, education$
3		and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and with the
4		authority to "consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal
5		agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation
6		."(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and
7	WHEREAS,	recently during a September 27, 2012 tribal consultation, Arizona's Medicaid program, and consultation description and consultation description descript
8		Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System ("AHCCCS"), provided the Legislative
9		Health and Human Services Committee and other tribes information regarding a
10		licensure issue with the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare ("CMS"); and
11	WHEREAS,	AHCCCS provided a July 20, 2012 letter from CMS in which CMS asks AHCCCS to
12		terminate a practice dating back at least eleven years of accepting official tribal
13		attestations to meet CMS licensure requirements for private entities operating on
14		reservations that are neither IHS or self-governance contract facilities; and
15	WHEREAS,	in a September 14, 2012 response, AHCCCS questions why after years of accepting
16		tribal attestations and affirming tribal rights to self-governance and self-
17	:	${\bf determination}, CMS \ is \ now \ implementing \ a \ change \ in \ policy \ without \ meaning fultribal$
18		consultation; and
19	WHEREAS,	$CMS's\ July\ 20,2012\ letter\ also\ indicates\ that\ instead\ of\ tribal\ attestations,\ the\ private$
20		health facilities operating on reservations that are neither IHS or self-governance
21		$contract facilities would \ have to obtain state \ licensure pursuant to 42 \ CFR \ 440 \ Subpart$
22		A; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has one such facility operating on the Nation's lands
24		providing the rapeutic and counseling services to 159 youth and 91 adults and receives to 159 youth and 91 adults and receives to 159 youth and 91 adults and 100 to 100
25		AHCCCS reimbursements for AHCCCS enrollees; and
26	WHEREAS,	under theDepartmentofHealthandHumanServices'TribalConsultationPolicy, each
27		"division shall, to the extent practicable and permitted by law, consider any
28		application by an Indian Tribe for a waiver with a general view toward increasing
29		opportunities for utilizing flexible approaches at the Indian Tribal level when the
30		proposed waiver is consistent with the applicable Federal policy objectives and is
31		otherwise appropriate." (Tribal Consultation Policy, Section 15); and

1	WHEREAS, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid's Tribal Consultation Policy affirms that "CMS
2	will fully comply with Section 15 of the HHS Tribal Consultation Policy on Tribal
3	waivers and process all requests routinely received for waivers under existing
4	program authorities with the statutorily set timeframes." (CMS Tribal Consultation
5	Policy, Section 13); and
6	WHEREAS, the current practice of accepting tribal attestations in lieu of state inspection and
7	licensing has been in place for at least eleven years and the CMS demand for state
8	licensure is a policy change that will significantly affect the tribes in Arizona,
9	including the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
10	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is requesting a waiver from the Centers for Medicare and
11	Medicaid for the requirement of state inspection and licensure of private facilities
12	operating on the Nation which are not IHS or self-governance facilities.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it requests
14	the Secretary of Health and Human Services to direct the Centers for Medicare and
15	Medicaid to waive the requirement of state inspection and licensure of private
16	facilities operating on the Nation which are not IHS or self-governance facilities and
17	to continue the practice of accepting tribal attestations.
18	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it authorizes the
19	Nation's chairperson or official designee to advocate for this waiver request and to
20	communicate directly with CMS and other appropriate state or federal departments
21	and agencies.
22 23	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>11TH</u> Day of <u>IANUARY</u> , <u>2013</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,678.30</u> FOR; <u>102.30</u>
