RESOLUTION NO. 13-025

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the Department of Justice, Office of
2 Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Technology Program Grant #2010-CK-
3 WX-0333;

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation requested and was approved for the no-cost extension for
5 the grant period by the U.S. Department of Justice, COPS from December 16, 2009
6 through June 15, 2014; and

7 WHEREAS, this grant and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants &
8 Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance
9 Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant amendment by the
10 Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
12 no-cost extension period and FY 2013 Budget of the Department of Justice Programs,
13 COPS Technology Program Grant #2010-CK-WX-0333 to utilize the Nation's resources
14 pending reimbursement from Grantor for the continuation of grant.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes
16 TONPD to expend funds from the Department of Justice, COPS Technology Program
17 Grant #2010-CK-WX-0333 in accordance with the terms of the grant award period of
18 December 16, 2009 to June 15, 2014.

19 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
20 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as
21 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
22 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH Day
24 of JANUARY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,568.70 FOR; -0-
25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 211.90[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
26 by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
27 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
