**RESOLUTION NO. 13-026**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and was awarded the Department of Justice,**  
2 **Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Operation First-Line Defense**  
3 **for Using Intelligence-Led Policing to Combat Narcotic Trafficking, Grant No. 2009-SD-**  
4 **B9-0118 in the amount of \$394,724.00 for Two years, from August 1, 2009 through July**  
5 **31, 2011; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation requested and was approved for a twelve (12) month no-**  
7 **cost extension until July 31, 2012. A second no-cost extension for six (6) month was**  
8 **requested and approved until January 31, 2012. A third no-cost extension for six (6)**  
9 **month was requested and approved until June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013 on the DOJ GMS system; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has requested and was approved a budget modification**  
11 **and a request for change of project scope to reallocate funds to Major Capital to**  
12 **purchase equipment and no-cost extension; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Indirect Cost is not allowable due to no current approved Indirect Cost for the**  
14 **Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, this grant and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants &**  
16 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**  
17 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant amendment by the**  
18 **Legislative Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**  
20 **accepts the amended DOJ reallocated of grant funds, no-cost extension, and the FY**  
21 **2013 Budget totaling \$328,211.56 for the Operation First - Line Defense for Using**  
22 **Intelligence - Led Policing to Combat Narcotics Trafficking, Grant #2009-SD-B9-0118**  
23 **on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation General Fund.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**  
25 **Tohono O'odham Police Department to expend funds from the Department of Justice,**  
26 **Office of Justice Programs, Operation First - Line Defense for Using Intelligence - Led**  
27 **Policing to, Grant #2009-SD-B9-0118 in accordance with the terms of the grant award**  
28 **for the period of August 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
30 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**


1 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is

6 by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
7 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
9 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
