14		Nation; and
15	WHEREAS,	this grant and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants &
16		Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance
17		Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant amendment by the
18		Legislative Council.
