1	WHEREAS, on June 28, 1997, the Nation's voters approved Initiative No. IN-01-97, the "Tohon
2	O'odham Voice in the Use of Gaming Revenues" ("Initiative"), which authorizes pe
3	capita payments to the Nation's members provided that sufficient gaming revenue
4	are available; and
5	WHEREAS, the Ordinance for the Regulation of Gaming Activities within the Tohono O'odhar
6	Nation ("Gaming Ordinance") was subsequently amended to authorize per capit
7	distribution payments in accordance with the Initiative (Legislative Counc
8	Resolution No. 97-303); and
9	WHEREAS, the Trust Agreement with Wells Fargo Bank requires that a listing of all mino
10	beneficiaries turning 18 that month be presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislativ
11	Council to obtain approval to distribute the trust funds to these eligible mino
12	members as they are no longer restricted beneficiaries; and
13	WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has determined that the minors identified on the Monthly Ag
14	18 Report for February 2013 reached the age of 18 and are no longer restricted from
15	receiving their per capita payments; and
16	WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has verified that the beneficiaries on the Monthly Age 18 Repor
17	for February 2013 are also listed on the applicable master minor listing approved b
18	Legislative Council resolution.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20	Monthly Age 18 Report for February 2013 and authorizes Wells Fargo Bank to
21	commence payment to the non-restricted beneficiaries listed on the Monthly Age 1
22	Report for February 2013, subject to the additional requirements of the trus
23	agreement and written confirmation of the beneficiary's current mailing address and
24	other information.
25 26 27	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>04<sup>TH</sup></u> Day of <u>FEBRUARY</u> , <u>2013</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,780.60</u> FOR; <u>-0</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-NOT VOTING</u> ; and <u>[04]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Articles
28 29	VI, Section 1 <u>(d)(2)</u> of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary
