## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Agreement with New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District for 2013)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-043

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is entitled to receive a total of 66,000 acre-feet of Central
2	į	Arizona Project ("CAP") water per year; and
3	WHEREAS,	under the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act, as amended ("SAWRSA"),
4		Title III of Public Law 108-451, the Nation is authorized to utilize its CAP water either
5		on reservation or off reservation; and
6	WHEREAS,	in June 2012 the Nation entered into an agreement (the "2012 Agreement") with the
7		New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District ("NMIDD"), which is designated as a
8		groundwater savings facility under Arizona law, to deliver a portion of the Nation's
9		CAP entitlement to NMIDD as "in-lieu water"; and
10	WHEREAS,	the 2012 Agreement was successfully implemented and resulted in delivery of a
11		substantial amount of the Nation's CAP entitlement to NMIDD and a substantial
12		payment by NMIDD to the Nation; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee has recommended that the Nation enter into a
14		similar one year agreement with NMIDD for 2013; and
15	WHEREAS,	the 2013 Agreement is similar to the 2012 Agreement, except for minor revisions that
16		update the information in the Agreement and that respond to questions raised by the
17		U.S. Department of the Interior in its review of the 2012 Agreement; and
18	WHEREAS,	under both the 2012 and the 2013 Agreements, in addition to the payments for the
19		water, the  Nation  will  accumulate  marketable  long-term  storage  credits  through  the  long-term  storage  credits  storage  credits  through  storage  credits  storage
20		use by NMIDD of the Nation's CAP water instead of NMIDD pumping and using
21		groundwater within the irrigation district itself; and
22	WHEREAS,	the 2013 Agreement is for a term of one year, and the Nation can decide at the end of
23		that year whether to continue the arrangement; and
24	WHEREAS,	in Section 10 of the Agreement, the Nation has agreed to provide a limited waiver of
25		sovereign immunity to allow for dispute resolution in any court of competent
26		juris diction, not to include Arizona state courts, which waiver is limited to declaratory
27		and injunctive relief to enforce the Agreement but does not include a waiver of any
28		claims for money damages, attorney's fees, court costs or any other costs, damages,
29		remedy, or claims of any other kind; and

RESOLUTION NO. 13-043 (Approving Agreement with New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District for 2013) Page 2 of 3 WHEREAS, the Water Resources and the Domestic Affairs Committees have reviewed the 1 2 Agreement and recommend approval by the Legislative Council. 3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves 4 the Agreement Between New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District and the Tohono 5 O'odham Nation Providing for the Delivery of In-lieu Water for Water Storage at a 6 Groundwater Savings Facility for the year 2013 and hereby authorizes the Chairman 7 of the Nation to execute the Agreement and any additional documentation reasonably 8 necessary to implement the intent of the Agreement, provided that any extensions of 9 the Agreement beyond December 31, 2013 shall require review and approval by the 10 Legislative Council. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves a limited 11 waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity to allow disputes arising between the 12 parties with respect to this 2013 Agreement to be resolved in any court of competent 13 14 jurisdiction, not to include Arizona state courts, and limits the waiver to declaratory and injunctive relief to enforce the Agreement but does not waive its sovereign 15 immunity with respect to any claims for money damages, attorney's fees, court costs 16 17 or any other costs, damages, remedy, or claims of any other kind. The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> Day 18 of FEBRUARY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; \_-0-19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI and Section 2 of Article XVII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham 21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting 22 23 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 24 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 25 26 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 27 28 29 30 Timothy Joaquin, Legislative Chairman 31 May of Relowary, 2013 32 33 34 35 36 37 38
