

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the No Cost Extension and Carry Forward of the US Department of
Homeland Security, FEMA, 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal
#2009-SS-T9-007 in the amount of \$23,435.32 with an original
performance period of 08/01/2009 to 07/31/2012)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-058

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management**
2 **Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants to states to fund for purchases that provide**
3 **public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, eligible Indian tribes have been designated to receive direct funding from the**
5 **Department of Homeland Security – FEMA established from the 9-11**
6 **Recommendations Act; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation had submitted and was awarded a grant from FEMA as**
8 **part of the 2009 State Homeland Security Program - Tribal to help strengthen the**
9 **Nation against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks and natural disasters;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, the 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal Grant No. 2009-SS-T9-0073 had a**
12 **remaining balance in the amount of \$23,435.32 at the end of the grant period**
13 **(07/31/2012) and the Office of Emergency Management requested and was approved**
14 **for the No-Cost Extension to 04/30/2013 from FEMA, which was approved; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal Grant No. 2009-SS-T9-0073 No Cost**
16 **Extension and carry forward funds has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of**
17 **Grants & Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget &**
18 **Finance Committee, of which all approval by the Legislative Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **approved No Cost Extension to 04/30/2013 and carry forward funds in the amount of**
21 **\$23,435.32 of the 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal No. 2009-SS-T9-0073**
22 **on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation General Fund.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**
24 **the Office of Emergency Management to expend funds from the FEMA 2009 State**
25 **Homeland Security Program – Tribal in accordance with the terms of the grant award**
26 **period of 08/01/09 to 04/30/2013 in the amount of \$23,435.32 and further waives**
27 **indirect costs to administer this grant.**



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
1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**

9 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
10 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
11 **Stat. 984).**
