## LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Finding Judge Michael T. Telep, Jr. Responsible for Committing Conduct Prejudicial to Administration of Justice as Charged in Count 2 of the Suspension Statement)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-060

1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is exclusively vested with the authority to suspend Nation's
2		judges from office for criminal conduct, gross neglect of duty, and other grounds,
3		subject to a reasonable cause determination by the Judiciary Committee and a final
4		determination by the Legislative Council (6 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Suspension of Judges);
5		and
6	WHEREAS,	upon commencement of proceedings with the Judiciary Committee, the Committee
7	Ē	is vested with authority to determine whether "there is reasonable cause to believe
8		that the accused judge has committed an offense for which suspension is available as
9		charged in the suspension statement" (6 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4104); and
10	WHEREAS,	on  December  13,2012  a  written  statement  for  suspension  from  of fice  (the  ``Suspension')  and  for  suspension  from  of fice  (the  ``Suspension')  and  for  suspension'  for  suspension'
11		Statement") was filed with the Judiciary Committee Chairperson in accordance with
12		the 6 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4103 by Chief Judge Teresa Donahue (the "Accuser")
13		against Tohono O'odham Nation Judge Michael T. Telep, Jr. (the "Accused Judge")
14		alleging the Accused Judge committed an offense for which suspension is available;
15		and
16	WHEREAS,	the Accused Judge was served with notice of the hearing, the Suspension Statement,
17		and the Judicial Suspension Reasonable Cause Hearing Procedures adopted by
18		Judiciary Committee Resolution No. 12-01; and
19	WHEREAS,	on January 16, 2013, the Judiciary Committee conducted a reasonable cause hearing
20		in accordance with the provisions of Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 4104 of the Tohono
21		O'odham Code and determined there is reasonable cause that the Accused Judge
22		committed an offense of conduct prejudicial to administration of justice as charged
23		in Count 2 of the Suspension Statement (Judiciary Committee Resolution No. 13-05);
24		and
25	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, Section 4104(D), the Legislative
26		Judiciary Committee filed with the Secretary of the Legislative Council a copy of the
27		Suspension Statement and Judiciary Committee Resolution No. 13-05; and
28	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Order No. 13-024, the Legislative Council set a judicial suspension
29		hearing for the Accused Judge for February 8, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. and adopted Judicial
30		Suspension Hearing Procedures to govern the suspension proceedings; and
31	WHEREAS,	in accordance with Section 4105 of 6 T.O.C. Chapter 4 and the Judicial Suspension
32		Hearing Procedures, the Accused Judge was personally served on January 29, 2013 with

1	(1) notice of the February 8, 2013 suspension hearing, (2) a copy of the Suspension
2	Statement, (3) copy of Judiciary Committee Resolution No. 13-05, and (4) copy of the
3	Judicial Suspension Hearing Procedures; and
4	WHEREAS, the Accused Judge was given notice and the opportunity to be present at the
5	suspension hearing, be represented by legal counsel, call and question witnesses
6	cross-examine witnesses against him, make opening and closing statements, file
7	motions, make objections, present evidence, and otherwise answer the charges
8	contained in the Suspension Statement; and
9	WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 T.O.C. Chapter 4, subsection 4106(B), "During the term of a suspension
10	a suspended judge shall not exercise any powers of the Judicial Court and shall not be
11	deemed to continue in office."
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (1) finds Accused
13	Judge Michael T. Telep, Jr. responsible for committing an offense of conduc
14	prejudicial to administration of justice as charged in Count 2 of the Suspension
15	Statement, and (2) suspends Accused Judge Michael T. Telep, Jr. from office for 60 days
16	during which he shall not perform any services or exercise any powers of a Judicia
17	Court judge and he shall not be deemed to continue in office.
