

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, FFY 2012 Homeland
Security Grant Program, HS Initiatives Planning, Grant Agreement No. 999418-01
for \$55,000)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-071

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to**
2 **counties, through their respective states, to fund equipment purchases and training**
3 **by departments that provide public safety services within their respective**
4 **jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the FY 2012 Department**
6 **Of Homeland Security, Arizona Department of Homeland Security, titled HS Initiatives**
7 **Planning, Subgrantee Agreement No. 12-AZDOHS-HSGP-999418-01 in the amount of**
8 **\$55,000 for the Office of Emergency Management; and**

9 **WHEREAS, indirect costs are not allowable under the Arizona Department of Homeland Security**
10 **grant programs; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Subgrantee Agreement No. 12-AZDOHS-HSGP-999418-01 has been reviewed by the**
12 **Executive Branch Attorney and the Tohono O'odham Nation's Attorney General's**
13 **office; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the FY 2012 Homeland Security Grant Program, Initiatives Planning Subgrantee**
15 **Agreement No. 12-AZDOHS-HSGP-999418-01 and the FY 2013 budget for this award has**
16 **been reviewed by the Budget Office, Office of Grants & Contracts, Executive Office,**
17 **Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee, of which all**
18 **recommend approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
20 **accepts the FY 12 Homeland Security Grant Program Award, titled HS Initiatives**
21 **Planning, Subgrantee Agreement No. 12-AZDOHS-HSGP-999418-01 in the amount of**
22 **\$55,000.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2013**
24 **budget and authorizes the expenditure of funds in accordance with the terms of the**
25 **2012 State Homeland Security Program, Initiatives Planning for the period covering**
26 **October 01, 2012 through September 30, 2013 on a reimbursement basis from the**
27 **Tohono O'odham Nation's General Fund; and further waives indirect costs to**
28 **administer this grant.**



1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation's Offices to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairperson and any designated official are
3 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
4 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted
5 for further prior approval.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day
7 of MARCH, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-
8 AGAINST; -02- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
9 Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
10 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
11 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
12 Stat. 984).


