

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Amendment 1 of the FY 2013 Law Enforcement budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-072**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department's (TONPD) FY 2013 Law Enforcement**  
2 **Tribal budget was approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council per**  
3 **Resolution No. 12-208; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has amended its Tribal Law Enforcement budget; and**

5 **WHEREAS, amendment #1 to the TONPD has added line item 7040 Ammunition; and**

6 **WHEREAS, has increased line item 7050 Firearms & Tasers and line item 7200 Freight/Postage;**  
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, line items 7110 Communication Expense and 7345 Consultants have been decreased;**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, this amendment has not changed the bottom line; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department's amendment #1 to the Tribal Law**  
12 **Enforcement FY 2013 has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Executive Office,**  
13 **Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee of the Legislative**  
14 **Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval and adoption.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
16 **approved the Tribal Law Enforcement budget amendment #1 to add new line item 7040**  
17 **Ammunition, increase line items, decreased line items and the budget amount of**  
18 **\$8,140,038.33 does not change for FY 2013.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
24 **of MARCH, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
26 **VI, Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
