

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance of Elder Abuse Prevention Intervention Award No. 90ET0433/01 and**  
**Approval of FY2013 grant budget in the amount of \$82,237)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-086**

1 **WHEREAS, the Division of Adult Protective Service (APS) provide services to abused, neglected and**  
2 **exploited elders and vulnerable adults; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the U. S. Administration on Aging announced the Native American Elder Abuse**  
4 **Prevention Intervention grant in June 2012; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services, Adult**  
6 **Protective Service Division submitted a proposal to the announcement with the**  
7 **following goals: (1) to increase elder abuse awareness and skills among service**  
8 **providers for improved service response and coordination through adaptation of**  
9 **existing curriculum and (2) to improve early identification of elders caregivers at risk**  
10 **of abuse behavior, through adaption and pilot testing screening tools for use by multi-**  
11 **disciplinary professionals in in-home and clinical settings; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was notified in October 2012 the grant application had**  
13 **been selected and awarded a three year grant amount of \$82,237.00 for FY2013, FY2014**  
14 **and FY2015 with a total award of \$246,711.00; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**  
16 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval and**  
17 **adoption.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 19 **1. Accepts the Native American Elder Abuse Interventions Preventions grant award**  
20 **of \$246,711.00 for a three year grant period October 1, 2012 through September 30,**  
21 **2015.**
- 22 **2. Accepts, approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the FY 2013**  
23 **attached budget in the amount of \$82,237.00 which includes indirect costs.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit, the Chairperson and**  
25 **any designated official is hereby authorized to expand the grant funds, provided**  
26 **however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget**  
27 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
28 **Council.**

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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup> Day  
2 of MARCH, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-  
3 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article  
4 VI, Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
5 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
6 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
7 Stat. 984).



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
