16		until September 27, 2013 (Resolution No. 13-040); and
17	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's best interest to appoint interim commissioners to the TERO
18		Commission so that the Commission may conduct business, ensure that Indian
19		preference is enforced, and provide necessary services for the Nation's members; and

23	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the TohonoO'odhamLegislativeCouncilhere by appoints
24		Bernadette E. Blackwater as an interim TERO Commissioner for a term expiring
25		September 27, 2013, except as otherwise provided by subsequent action of the
26		Legislative Council.
27	BE IT FINA	MLLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that interim TERO
28		Commissioner Bernadette E. Blackwater is authorized to exercise the duties of a TERO

commissioner pursuant to the TERO Ordinance, provided that the Nation's chairperson or the chairperson's designee shall retain the authorities delegated by Resolution No. 13-040 as modified in the manner described below:

- (1) Manage and expend funds under the Commission's FY 2013 budgets, provided that subject to review and approval by the Nation's chairperson or chairperson's designee, the Interim Commission may request expenditures of funds in order to
- (2) Exercise the Commission's signature authority, except that the Interim Commission shall exercise independent signature authority for Commission correspondence, issuing written hearing decisions, adopting rules and regulations, and other matters that do not directly authorize the expenditure of
- (3) Secure and/or take control of all TERO Commission property and assets, including but not limited to all bank accounts, credit cards and accounts, real and personal property, financial and other records and documents; provided that the Interim Commission shall have access to property and records necessary to perform its functions if such access does not impede any criminal investigation and may expend funds in accordance with the additional provisions of this resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15^{TH} Day of MARCH, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (b) 1(c)(2) 1(d) and 1 (1) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
