13	WHEREAS, t	he Enrollment Office has determined that the minors identified on the Monthly Age
14	]	8 Report for May 2013 reached the age of 18 and are no longer restricted from
15		eceiving their per capita payments; and
16	WHEREAS, t	he Enrollment Office has verified that the beneficiaries on the Monthly Age 18 Report
17	f	or May 2013 are also listed on the applicable master minor listing approved by
