

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of Amendment #2 to the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-147**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Amendment #1 of the FY2013**  
2 **Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant Budget by Resolution No. 12-446; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant extends from October 1, 2011 through September**  
4 **30, 2013; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Grants and Contracts have identified an unobligated balance in the amount of**  
6 **\$11,285.49 for FY2012 and the Environmental Protection Office (EPO) requests to**  
7 **amend the FY2013 Budget to include the unobligated amount as identified; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the FY2013 budget will increase from \$90,000.00 to \$101,285.49; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the following line items will be increased: 7340 Public Relations and 7355 Professional**  
10 **Services; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee of the Legislative**  
12 **Council has reviewed Budget Amendment #2 and recommend its approval and**  
13 **adoption.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
15 **Amendment #2 in accordance with the budget attached hereto:**

- 16 **1. To increase line items: 7340 Public Relations and 7355 Professional Services.**
- 17 **2. Changing the budget amount from \$90,000.00 to \$101,285.49.**
- 18 **3. Authorizing EPO to expend all available funds awarded pursuant to the EPA**  
19 **Cooperative Agreement for the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
21 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**  
22 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the**  
23 **budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
26 **of MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




