

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting Amended Plans of Operation for the Budget and Finance, Domestic Affairs,
Health and Human Services and Human Resources Development Committees)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-153

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to establish rules**
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**
3 **standing committees, boards and special committees (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a) and (b)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has adopted and amended the Legislative Rules of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Rules") to govern the general structure of**
7 **the Council's standing committees; and**

8 **WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules provides that "The Rules Committee**
9 **shall review and make recommendations of proposed legislative committee plans of**
10 **operation and amendments to plans of operation to the Legislative Council."; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation for the Rules Committee also delegates to the Committee**
12 **jurisdiction over Legislative Council committee organization and plans of operation**
13 **(Rules Plan of Operation, Article III.C.2.(a)); and**

14 **WHEREAS, on October 30, 2013 by Resolution No. 12-423, the Legislative Council approved Tohono**
15 **O'odham Nation Code, Title 27, Chapter 1, Creation of the Hia-Ced District of the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council's 12 standing committees will need to be restructured to**
18 **accommodate two additional representatives from the Hia-Ced District; and**

19 **WHEREAS, after conferring with the Legislative Council and affected committees, the Rules**
20 **Committee has drafted amended plans of operation for the Budget and Finance,**
21 **Domestic Affairs, and Health and Human Services Committees as dated for reference**
22 **May 2013 that will allow all representatives to serve on three standing committees;**
23 **and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee further recommends the transfer of oversight of the TERO Office**
25 **and TERO Commission from the Domestic Affairs Committee to the Human Resources**
26 **Development Committee and has drafted amendments to these Committees' plans of**
27 **operation to reflect the change in oversight; and**

28 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed and recommends adoption of amended plans of**
29 **operation for the Budget and Finance, Domestic Affairs, Health and Human Services**
30 **and Human Resources Development Committees, and the committees have approved**
31 **the amendments to their respective plans of operation.**

(Adopting Amended Plans of Operation for the Budget and Finance, Domestic Affairs, Health and Human Services and Human Resources Development Committees)


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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the
2 amended plans of operation for the Budget and Finance, Domestic Affairs, Health and
3 Human Services, and Human Resources Development Committees as dated for
4 reference May 2013 and which will replace those committees' existing plans of
5 operation.

6 BE IT FINALLY ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that this legislative order
7 shall become effective during the June 2013 general session upon the Legislative
8 Council's vote to issue certificates of election in accordance with Section 6.N. of Article
9 VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance.

10 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of
11 MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
12 -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,
13 Section 1 (a) and (b) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
14 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
15 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
16 Stat. 984).


