16]	Election Board or any member thereof," the Legislative Council has jurisdiction to

18	WHEREAS, i	in accordance with the Council's constitutional authority to "establish rules and
19	1	procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" the Legislative
20		Council adopted Election Contest Hearing Procedures to govern contests to the

23	WHEREAS, 1	the Legislative Rules Committee recommends that the Council adopt the "Election
