

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Submission of Legislative Committee Quarterly Reports)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-155

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O’odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees.” (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XI, Section 1(A) of the Legislative Rules, there are 12 standing**
6 **committees of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council whose memberships are**
7 **comprised of representatives to the Legislative Council (Rules of the Legislative**
8 **Council (“Legislative Rules”)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the duties and powers of all Legislative Council committees are prescribed under**
10 **individual committee plans of operations that have been adopted by the Legislative**
11 **Council and more generally under Article XI, Section 3 of the Legislative Rules; and**

12 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Order No. 10-450, legislative committees provide committee**
13 **reports to the full Legislative Council on a quarterly basis regarding matters within**
14 **the committees’ specific responsibilities and areas of oversight; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee recommends that Legislative Committees continue to submit**
16 **condensed, written committee reports on a quarterly basis to the full Legislative**
17 **Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that each**
19 **Legislative Council committee shall submit to the Legislative Council a brief, written**
20 **quarterly report that summarizes (1) current committee business and**
21 **accomplishments and (2) identifies future legislative committee goals and objectives.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that each Legislative Council standing committee, at least one week**
23 **before every general election, shall produce a written list of pending projects and**
24 **priorities that shall be provided to Council and to the committee members elected by**
25 **the Council after the general election.**

26 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of**
27 **MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
29 **Section 1 (a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O’odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Ac**
32 **t of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
