1 **WHEREAS, at a regular session of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council held on May 08, 2013;**
 2 **and**
 3 **WHEREAS, Lester Parley, Artesia/Little Tucson representative presented their FY 2013 Budget**
 4 **Amendment #1; and**
 5 **WHEREAS, this amendment is utilizing identified, carryovers from FY 2012, in the amount of**
 6 **\$131,454.08, and will be utilizing \$43,068.27 to add 7 new positions in the Occasional**
 7 **Appointment line item and to replenish depleted line items for the remainder of the**
 8 **FY 2013 fiscal year; and**
 9 **WHEREAS, the remaining amount of \$88,385.81 will be used at a later time; and**
 10 **WHEREAS, the FY 2013 Budget Amendment #1 is needed for the following mentioned budget:**


3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this budget amendment #1 will increase Artesia/Little Tucson

5 \$163,316.25 and will also increase the overall district's FY 2013 budget of \$1,704,061.31
6 to a revised amount of \$1,747,129.58.

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the remainder amount of \$88,385.81 FY 2012 carryovers will be used
8 at a later time.

9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that any modifications, amendments or changes in the justification
10 shall be reviewed and approved by the Budget and Finance Committee and the Tohono
11 O'odham Legislative Council.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
13 of MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
14 -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,
15 Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
16 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
17 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




