

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Nation's Representative to the Tri-National Health Council)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-160

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the**
2 **authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education**
3 **and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members..." and with the**
4 **authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of**
5 **the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other**
6 **Indian tribes... within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution,**
7 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(f)); and**

8 **WHEREAS, members of the Nation reside and the Nation's traditional lands exist on both sides of**
9 **the international boundary between the United States and Mexico; and**

10 **WHEREAS, given the unique health issues faced by residents of Arizona, Sonora, and the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Nation, a Tri-National Health Council was formed to jointly address a wide**
12 **range of health issues of mutual concern; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Andrew Lorentine, Assistant Manager for the Nation's Department of Health and**
14 **Human Services Community Health Division, has served on the Tri-National Health**
15 **Council; and**

16 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members to appoint a**
17 **Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee member as the Nation's**
18 **representative to the Tri-National Health Council; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends appointing Rep. Arthur**
20 **Wilson to the Tri-National Health Council.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints Rep.**
22 **Arthur Wilson as the Nation's representative to the Tri-National Health Council,**
23 **provided that the Nation's Director of Health and Human Services or official designee**
24 **shall represent the Nation in the absence of the Nation's representative.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Rep. Arthur Wilson's**
26 **authority to represent the Nation shall immediately terminate if he is no longer**
27 **serving on the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee.**



2 of MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
3 [01] NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,
4 Section 1(c)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
5 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
6 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
7 Stat. 984).
