

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Representative Sandra Ortega to Direct Service Tribes Advisory
Committee and Designating Alternate)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-162

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority to “consult with the Congress of the**
2 **United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities that affect**
3 **the Tohono O’odham Nation. . .” and “to promote, protect and provide for public**
4 **health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O’odham Nation**
5 **and its members. . .” (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(j) and Section 1(c)(2)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Direct Service Tribes Advisory Committee (“DSTAC”) was established on April 27,**
7 **2005 by the Indian Health Service (“IHS”) Director to provide expertise on policies,**
8 **guidelines, and programmatic issues that impact the delivery of health care for Indian**
9 **tribes with an emphasis on policies that impact the direct service tribes; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Nation is a direct service tribe that receives primary health care**
11 **directly from the Indian Health Service; and**

12 **WHEREAS, since 2005, Rep. Sandra Ortega has represented the Nation’s interests, issues, and**
13 **concerns as an active participant on the Advisory Committee and most recently as the**
14 **Committee’s chairperson; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Nation’s chairperson affirmed Rep. Sandra Ortega’s original nomination to the**
16 **Advisory Committee by official correspondence; and**

17 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation to appoint Rep. Sandra Ortega by resolution and**
18 **to designate an alternate to act in Rep. Ortega’s absence.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it appoints**
20 **Rep. Sandra Ortega to the Direct Service Tribes Advisory Committee.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it designates Rep.**
22 **Arthur Wilson as Rep. Sandra Ortega’s alternate to the Direct Service Tribes Advisory**
23 **Committee, provided that the authority vested in both representatives shall**
24 **immediately expire if the representatives no longer serve on the Health and Human**
25 **Services Committee.**


