10	WHEREAS,	the proposed Research Code of the Tohono O'odham Nation establishes a permi
11		requirement for any researcher seeking to conduct research on the Nation, a review
12		and approval procedure by a Nation's Institutional Review Board consisting of five
13		Nation's enrolled members with relevant experience and expertise, and a
14		requirement that researchers enter into a research agreement with the Nation; and
