4		regulate the domestic affairs of members of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to
5		$ provide for the appointment of guardians or custodians for minors. \dots " (Constitution, custodians) description description $
6		Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(c)(3)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Children's Code of the Papago Tribe, currently compiled within the Tohono
8		O'odham Code as 3 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1, was enacted on February 13,
9		1979 to address child welfare issues, child offender proceedings, and the duties and
10		responsibilities of child welfare and child offender-related personnel; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Children's Code of the Papago Tribe is in need of substantial amendments and as
12		early as 2007, the Domestic Affairs Committee worked closely with the Nation's
13		Judicial Court, the Child Welfare Division, the Office of the Prosecutor, the
14		Department of Health and Human Services, and Office of Attorney General to
15		incorporate suggested comprehensive amendments to update and improve the
16		Children's Code; and
17	WHEREAS,	in 2010, 2012, and on March 27, 2013, the Domestic Affairs Committee provided drafts
18		of the revised Children's Code to the public and requested written comments; and
19	WHEREAS,	over the course of two years, the Domestic Affairs Committee reviewed numerous
20		${\bf publiccommentsandamendedthedraftsoftheChildren'sCodewiththecooperation}$
21		and assistance of the Child Welfare Division and Office of the Prosecutor; and
22	WHEREAS,	the proposed 3 Tohono O'odham Code Chapters 1-3 Children's Code includes
23		provisions for child in need of care proceedings; duties and responsibilities for
24		guardianships; outlines parental rights, provides a framework for child offender
25		proceedings and addresses other child welfare and child offender issues; and
26	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's best interest to repeal the "Children's Code of the Papago Tribe"
27		andenactthe"Children'sCodeoftheTohonoO'odhamNation"as3TohonoO'odhamArgonia andO'odhamArgonia andO'odhamArg
28		Code Chapters 1-3.
