LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Amending Legislative Rules to Prohibit Campaigning for Elected Office During Legislative Council Sessions)

DEFEATED LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-188

1	WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham Legislative						
2	Council with the power to establish rules and procedures to regulate all meetings of						
3	the Council and its standing committees (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,						
4	Article VI, Section 1(a)); and						
5	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has exercised this power by adopting and amending the						
6	Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Rules"),						
7	which include provisions governing conduct and debate during Council sessions; and						
8	WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to prohibit campaigning for elected office during a						
9	Legislative Council session.						
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends						
11	Article I, Section 2(B)(3) of the Legislative Rules to add the following:						
12	"During a Council session no person shall announce or promote the candidacy of any						
13	person running for an elected office of the Nation."						
14	BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that the amendment approved by this legislative order shall not affect						
15	or limit the Council's authority to allow or disallow broadcasts of Council sessions.						
16 17 18 19 20 21 22	The foregoing Order was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND Day of MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 723.50 FOR; 2,057.10 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
