

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Special Needs –
FY 2014 First Things First Community Based Parent Education Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-192

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes and prioritizes the importance of health,**
2 **education and general wellbeing of the children of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the First Thing First initiative was passed by Arizona Voters in 2006 via proposition 203**
4 **which increases the quality and access to early childhood programs that will ensure**
5 **all Arizona children enter school healthy and ready to learn; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes specific areas of need in the Division of Special**
7 **Needs to provide community based parent education; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the First Things First agreement stipulates the grantee may allocate up to 10% of the**
9 **direct cost for indirect cost; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee of**
11 **the Legislative Council have reviewed the budget in the amount of \$70,000.00 and**
12 **recommends its approval and adoption.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
14 **approves:**

- 15 **1. The budget in the amount of \$70,000.00 for the period of July 1, 2013 to June 30,**
16 **2014.**
- 17 **2. Authorize 10% indirect cost allocation.**
- 18 **3. Authorization to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from the**
19 **Grantor for the continuation of the agreement.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
21 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
22 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level will be**
23 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD Day**
25 **of MAY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; ~~0~~ AGAINST;**
26 **~~0~~ NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
27 **Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**




