

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Memorandum of Agreement Among the Members of the Tribal
Law Enforcement Consortium of Arizona)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-218

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has the authority and responsibility to protect and**
2 **provide for the health, safety and welfare of the Nation and its members; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, the ability to exchange law enforcement information among fellow Tribal Police**
4 **Departments is a crucial part of maintaining law and order and preventing and**
5 **reducing crime, thereby providing for the health, safety and welfare of the Nation and**
6 **its members; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Ak-Chin Police Department; Fort McDowell Police Department; Gila River Police**
8 **Department; Salt River Police Department; the Tohono O'odham Police Department**
9 **have come together to outline an organizational structure for the establishment of the**
10 **Tribal Law Enforcement Consortium of Arizona (TLECA) for the purposes of exchanging**
11 **authorized law enforcement information among the participating Tribal Police**
12 **Departments; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the terms of membership in the Consortium are prescribed by the Memorandum of**
14 **Agreement Among Members of the Tribal Law Enforcement Consortium of Arizona**
15 **Participating in the Tribal Law Enforcement Exchange Service (MOA), attached hereto;**
16 **and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, upon the effective date of the MOA, Members of the Consortium intend to exchange**
18 **authorized law enforcement information among the participating Members through**
19 **the use of the Tribal Law Enforcement Information Exchange System of Arizona**
20 **(LEIES), which will be maintained on the U.S Department of Justice Criminal Justice**
21 **Information Services (CJIS) National Data Exchange (N-DEx), which is a data repository**
22 **operated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and**
- 23 **WHEREAS, by approving the MOA, Authorized Personnel designated by each participating Tribal**
24 **Police Department will be entitled to access and exchange law enforcement**
25 **information using LEIES in accordance with the terms of the MOA and applicable laws**
26 **and policies to be developed by the participating Tribal Police Departments; and**
- 27 **WHEREAS, the attached MOA has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee which**
28 **recommends Legislative Council approval.**




1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the
2 Memorandum of Agreement Among the Members of the Tribal Law Enforcement
3 Consortium of Arizona, substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the
4 Chairman of the Nation to execute it.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
6 of JUNE, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
7 [01] NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,
8 Section 1 (c)(2), 1 (c)(6), 1(f) and 1(l) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
9 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
