

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting July 23-26, 2013 Special Session to Address the Nation's FY 2014 Budgets)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-275

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to
2 regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards
3 and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
4 Section 1(a)); and


5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council with
6 the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative Rules of the
7 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has requested a July 23-26, 2013 special session to
9 address the Nation's FY 2014 budgets and finances.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a July
11 23-26, 2013 special session to address the Nation's FY 2014 budgets and finances.

12 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of
13 JULY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0-
14 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section
15 1 (a) & 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
16 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
17 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
