

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Brownfields Section 128(a) FY2014 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-287

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment and**
2 **safe guarding the health and well-being of the Nation's members; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Environmental Protection Office (EPO) has submitted a**
4 **proposal to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency under the Brownfields Section**
5 **128(a) Tribal Response Program in the amount of \$90,000.00 for continued funding**
6 **which will be awarded in an Assistance Agreement; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant would allow the Program to continue to identify,**
8 **assess and conduct oversight at cleanup activities where contamination exists**
9 **throughout the Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the**
11 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
12 **adoption; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this budget does not include IDC as the agency will not allow IDC to be charged without**
14 **a current year IDC agreement.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
16 **the FY 2014 Budget in the amount of \$90,000.00 and to utilize the Nations resources**
17 **pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the continued funding of the grant.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the attached FY 2014 budget**
19 **which does not include IDC and authorizes the expenditure of funds according to this**
20 **budget which shall be in effect from October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman or their designee**
22 **to seek reimbursement or recoup any indirect cost expenses in the event an indirect**
23 **cost rate is subsequently approved by the National Business Center.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
25 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
26 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
27 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day of JULY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,722.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 224.2[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
