

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) Sexual Assault Grant under**  
**the Grant to Indian Tribal Governments Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-299

1 **WHEREAS, the prevention of sexual assault is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**  
2 **WHEREAS, the Healing Our People Through Empowerment (HOPE) Sexual Assault Program is**  
3 **working to raise awareness of sexual assault, provide direct and supportive services**  
4 **to victims and survivors of sexual assault; and**  
5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was granted \$900,000.00, for a three year grant project**  
6 **period of October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2012; and**  
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will be requesting a no cost extension for FY 2014 in the**  
8 **amount of \$300,000; and**  
9 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the**  
10 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget amendment and recommend its**  
11 **approval and adoption.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 13 **1. Approves the Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) Sexual Assault Fiscal Year**  
14 **2014 Budget estimated at \$300,000 pending approval of a no cost extension from**  
15 **the funding agency and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement**  
16 **from the Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED should the Office of Violence Against Women Grant not receive further**  
18 **funding the Tohono O'odham Nation will not be obligated to utilize the Nation's**  
19 **resources beyond the no cost extension.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
21 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
22 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
23 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of JULY, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
28 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
29 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




