1	WHEREAS, the prevention of sexual assault is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
2	WHEREAS, the Healing Our People Through Empowerment (HOPE) Sexual Assault Program is
3	working to raise awareness of sexual assault, provide direct and supportive services
4	to victims and survivors of sexual assault; and
5	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was granted \$900,000.00, for a three year grant project
6	period of October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2012; and
7	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will be requesting a no cost extension for FY 2014 in the
8	amount of \$300,000; and
9	WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the
10	Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget amendment and recommend its
11	approval and adoption.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:
13	1. Approves the Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) Sexual Assault Fiscal Year
14	2014 Budget estimated at \$300,000 pending approval of a no cost extension from
15	the funding agency and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement
16	from the Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED should the Office of Violence Against Women Grant not receive further
18	funding the Tohono O'odham Nation will not be obligated to utilize the Nation's
19	resources beyond the no cost extension.
20	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
21	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
22	attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be
23	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
