15	pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.

17	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
18	attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
19	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
