## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting "September 2013 Amendments" to the TERO Ordinance)

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-352** 

1	WHEREAS,	all members of the Tohono O'odham Nation "shall be given equal opportunity to
2		participate in the economic resources and activities of the Tohono O'odham
3		Nation" (Constitution, Article III, Section 3); and
4	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council
5		with the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,
6		morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its
7		members"and (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and
8	WHEREAS,	on March 20, 1985, the Papago Council enacted the "Papago Employment Rights
9		Ordinance," Ordinance No. 01-85, which was amended in 2002 to add a
10		definition for "Indian preference laws, rules, regulations and guidelines"
11	:	(Resolution No. 02-390); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Papago Employment Rights Ordinance, commonly known and referred to as
13		the TERO Ordinance, needs to be updated to replace outdated references to the
14		Papago Tribe and make other changes; and
15	WHEREAS,	although the Human Resources Development Committee recognizes that the
16		TERO Ordinance requires more comprehensive amendments, at this time the
17		amendments appearing with the "September 2013 Amendments" to the TERO
18		Ordinance, which is incorporated by this reference, will update the terminology
19		appearing within the law and make other improvements; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development Committee therefore recommends that the
21		Legislative Council adopt the "September 2013 Amendments" to the TERO
22		Ordinance.
23	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the
24		"September 2013 Amendments" to the TERO Ordinance, which will appear
25		within the TERO Ordinance at 13 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1.
